Bob, Tim and I worked diligently and with great determination to present a program to the City of Rock Hill where your RHBC would run a program to continue training and retaining the youth that the City had recruited through their certification program at the Rock Hill Velodrome after the City's program ended. The City does a great introduction program for the youth of York County but what happens to them once they are finished with the program? This is where





the RHBC wanted to step in....but the City was simply not interested in working with us in a strategic way that would benefit the youth and be affordable for the RHBC. We are a volunteer club with amazing talent, but the City would not bend. This would have begun 10.1.21......So right now, Bob is still training a lot of Junior cyclists and working on another plan for Spring Cycling for the RHBC which I hope the new board will implement.

The Fall Harvest Ride was another huge success resulting in a great day of cycling for 134 riders, lots of new members and the ability to donate \$1500 to the Bethel Men's Shelter located in downtown Rock Hill SC and always in tremendous need for resources. Last year they used our donation to help pay for a large steel bike rack and a large concrete pad on which to install the bike rack. Bikes can serve as a primary source of transportation for many so the funds were well used. Ride by the shelter any day after 5 and you will see the bike rack is being well utilized.

We are nearing the end of another calendar year and cycling season but do not be dismayed! We have great plans ahead for you and all details will be included on the website which can be found at <u>rockhillbicycleclub.com</u>.
